Lesson Plans

For students who will begin Piano Lessons with Hoffman Academy Free Online, reminders are here:

☐ Piano Lesson 1 from Unit 1.

☐ Practice Piano for at least 15 minutes.

[1] Art Study combines art history, picture study, biography, and skills. During Art Study Term 1, give students a Sketch Pad and Drawing Pencil. There is no better way to learn to draw then to really look at a selected object of interest and practice.

Lesson 1: Art Study

You will need:

- Verse Pack 1
- Everyday Graces: A Child's Book of Good Manners
- Picture Study 1: Pre-flood Period
- You Can Draw in 30 Days + Drawing Supplies
- Grimm's Fairy Tales

Scripture Memory: Recite together *Psalm 23* or another favorite verse from *Verse Pack 1* for about 5 minutes.

Habits: Read together *Everyday Graces: A Child's Book of Good Manners*, Chapter 1: Good Manners at Home, "Honor Your Father and Mother" (page 3 only). Write "honor" on the chalkboard and read its definition. Discuss.

Art Study: Look at *Picture Study 1* together and read the back. Enjoy drawing together with *You Can Draw in 30 Days*, Lesson 1, "The Sphere." for 20 minutes, preferably outdoors! [1] Ask students to choose a *Drawing Project* for Term 1 (Weeks 1-12). Use *Worksheet 1* to help you plan it (see Extras).

Tip: Older students should read, outline, and summarize Great Artists: Volume 1 or The Annotated Mona Lisa - about 1 page per day.

Family Literature: Read together a selection from *Grimm's Fairy Tales* and ask for an oral narration. **Older Students** (grades 7-12) should sign-up for *Great Books 101: Ancient to Medieval*, a free online course at Hillsdale.edu. Listen to *Lecture 1* and borrow *The Iliad*, translated by Robert Fagles, from the library. Read together or assign Chapter 1.

Lesson 2: Latin Study

You will need:

- Verse Pack 1
- Prima Latina
- A Child's Garden of Verses
- Grimm's Fairy Tales and The Iliad (grades 7-12)

Scripture Memory: Recite together *Psalm 23 KJV* or another favorite verse from *Verse Pack 1.* (5 minutes)

Poetry Study: Read together "Bed in Summer" from *A Child's Garden of Verses* by Robert Louis Stevenson, page 9.



Latin Study: Read together *Prima Latina*, Lesson 1, and recite new words. Complete Lesson 1 Worksheet if desired.^[2]

Family Literature: Read together one selection from *Grimm's Fairy Tales* and ask for an oral narration. **Grades 7-12:** Listen to Lecture 2: Homer's Iliad at *Great Books 101: Ancient to Medieval*. Read together or assign *The Iliad*, Chapter 2. Ask for a short oral or written narration.

Lesson 3: Music Study

You will need:

- Verse Pack 1
- Everyday Graces: A Child's Book of Good Manners
- Book of Mottoes
- Classics for Kids
- Grimm's Fairy Tales and The Iliad (grades 7-12)

Scripture Memory: Recite together Psalm 23 KJV or other from Verse Pack 1.

Habits: Read together *Everyday Graces: A Child's Book of Good Manners*, Chapter 1, "Pansies" (pages 4-5). In a *Book of Mottoes*, ask students to copy the quote by Johann Wolfgang Von Goethe.

Music Study: Listen to *Classics for Kids*, Johann Sebastian Bach, "Brandenburg Concerto No. 2: Movement 1." [3]

Family Literature: Read together one selection from *Grimm's Fairy Tales* allowing students to illustrate as desired. **Grades 7-12:** Read together or assign *The Iliad*, Chapter 3. Ask for a short narration.

Lesson 4: Nature Study

You will need:

- Nature Notebook
- Field Guides, Pencils, and Watercolors

Nature Study: Enjoy a nature walk together as a family. Ask students to choose one item of interest (bird, tree, plant, etc.) to draw in their Nature Notebook. Identify and record the Latin name by using the Field Guides.

Timeline & Notes

Practice Piano for at least 15 minutes.

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[2] Begin each Latin Study with a recitation of all previous lessons to build long-term memory.

[3] We recommend piano lessons or choir to round out a child's Music Study.
