Letter to Parent

Handwriting is easy to teach in 3 simple steps!

1. **I do!** First, show your child how to form the letter correctly on the chalkboard. Say, "Watch me." Name each stroke as you write the letter.
2. **We do!** Next, let your child practice tracing and copying the letter on the chalkboard with you. Guide hand as needed.
3. **You do!** Finally, give your child this copybook and let them work independently.

Teaching Tips!

- Do handwriting for 10 minutes, 2 days per week.
- Day 1 – Teach the lesson and do Page I – Tracing.
- Day 2 – Review lesson¹ and do Page II – Copywork.
- Check for proper handwriting posture (see page 5).
- Recite spelling words & verses daily to memorize.
- Give spelling dictations weekly (optional – page 78).

¹ Reteach letter formation on the chalkboard if child needs reminded on how to form each stroke.

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Getting Started!

Getting started with handwriting is easy!

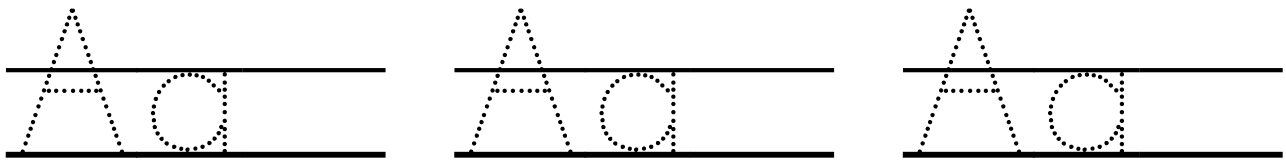
4. **Get Ready!** Start with good posture. Sit up straight in your chair with feet on floor.
5. **Get Set!** Hold pencil with correct grip.
6. **Go!** Trace and copy the lesson as neatly as you can. With practice you will win at handwriting!



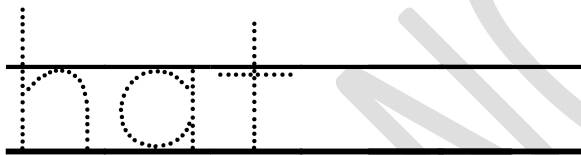
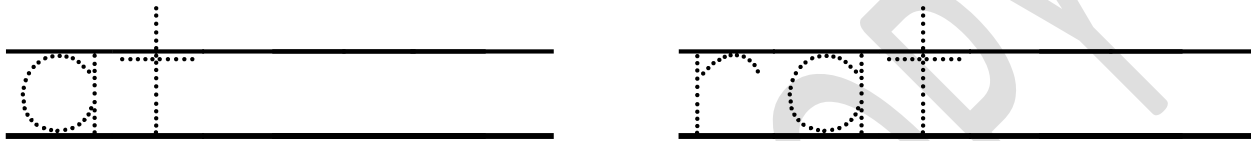
Don't forget! During the lesson, watch your parent (or teacher) carefully, to see how to form each letter correctly.

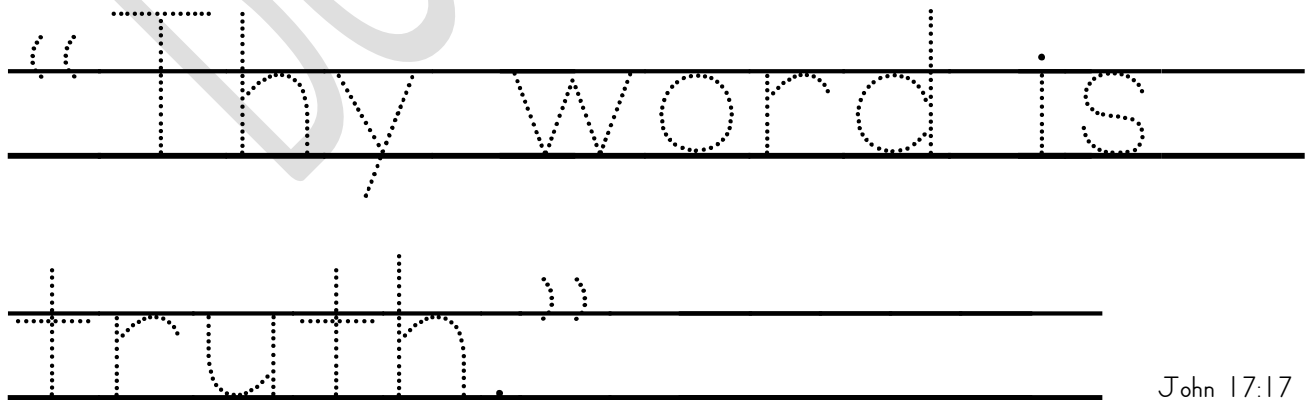
Part I: Letter. Trace the letter Aa.
