Enjoying a Year of Scripture Verses is a family together study! Simply print off the 18 verse cards. Use them for scripture memory in *Enrichment Study 1* plus they coordinate with the copywork in *Christian Study 1* with additional suggestions. *Verse Pack 1* uses the *King James Version*, selected for its literary beauty, unless noted. Enjoy learning scripture together with your whole family. Simply cut-out *Verse Card 1* and read it aloud for about 5 minutes. Invite your children to join in when ready. Repeat daily until your children can say it from memory. Then move onto the next verse. Our teacher guides assign when to learn each verse giving ample time to memorize, but of course, you can go at your own family's pace. Memorize about two verses per month to complete in one year.
